Take photos and present to management

J	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jack it out June, January or Lent (Give up smoking, drinking, chocolate or anything and donate the money you would have spent to Humanitas to help people with drug dependence. • Jail break (dress up and be sponsored per mile you can get away from a starting point.) • Jigsaw marathon (have a number of people complete a number of jigsaw puzzles in a race. • Joke Day • Juggling • Juice Stand • Jumping Castle

Set rules for circumstances that may call for breaking the rules. Approach everyone you to know to sponsor you and make sure that you can sign off on the hours that have been achieved. • Sports Day- Golf, Tennis, • Social Media (update all your media details with Humanitas details) • Swear Jar • Swimming Day
